The Museums Centre of Ascoli Satriano (Foggia - Italy), which includes the Civic Museum and the Diocesan Museum displays a permanent exhibition **"Sublime polychromy "** with fascinating polychrome gryphons dated IV century BC.

"The necessary waste. The magnificence in the tombs of Ascoli Satriano" is the title of the exhibition, curated by Marisa Corrente at the Museums of Ascoli Satriano (Foggia), on the occasion of the hundred and fiftieth anniversary of the Italy Unification.

The event takes place within the Museums Centre of Ascoli Satriano which houses a collection of the Diocese of Cerignola-Ascoli Satriano and an exceptional complex of Hellenistic marbles from the Paul Getty Museum, returned to the nation thanks to the cultural politics of recent years that Italy has secured the return of valuable artefacts taken from the archaeological area.
